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Investment Objective and Strategies

The Evolve Cyber Security Index Fund (the "Fund") invests primarily in equities of global companies that are involved in the cyber security industry. The Fund seeks to replicate, to the extent reasonably possible and before fees and expenses, the performance of the Solactive Global Cyber Security Index Canadian Dollar Hedged, or any successor thereto.

Risk

Effective July 15, 2026, the risk rating of the Hedged ETF Units, Unhedged ETF Units, Hedged Class A Mutual Fund Units, and Hedged Class F Mutual Fund Units of the Fund was changed from "Medium to High" to "High." There were no other changes to the Fund over the period of this report that materially affected the level of risk associated with an investment in the Fund. Prospective investors should read the Fund's most recent prospectus and consider the description of risks contained therein.

Results of Operations

For the six-month period ended June 30, 2026, the Unhedged ETF Units returned 43.2% versus the Solactive Global Cyber Security Index NTR return of 44.2%. The Hedged ETF Units returned 37.5% versus the Solactive Global Cyber Security Index Canadian Dollar Hedged return of 39.1%. The US Dollar Unhedged ETF Units returned 38.5% versus the Solactive Global Cyber Security USD Index NTR return of 39.4%. The Hedged Class A Mutual Fund Units returned 36.7% and the Hedged Class F Mutual Fund Units returned 37.5% versus the Solactive Global Cyber Security Index Canadian Dollar Hedged return of 39.1%. The Fund's net assets were \$221.5MM as at June 30, 2026.

Portfolio Manager Commentary

Global cybersecurity stocks dropped in late February 2026 after Anthropic previewed an AI tool that could scan software for security vulnerabilities, raising concern that AI might take over work done by cybersecurity vendors.¹

The sector saw major acquisitions in the first half of 2026, including Palo Alto Networks' roughly US\$25 billion purchase of CyberArk, which closed in mid-February. The deal pushed Palo Alto Networks into identity security, an area where it previously had no products, and made it a core part of the company's platform alongside network security and security operations. With identity now a primary target for attackers, the purchase gave Palo Alto Networks a major position in that market.²

In early April, Anthropic launched Project Glasswing, an initiative to secure critical software using its most capable model, Claude Mythos Preview. Its launch partners included the cybersecurity vendors CrowdStrike and Palo Alto Networks, and Anthropic extended access to more than 40 other organizations that maintain critical software. The initiative placed established security firms at the centre of defending software against AI-driven threats.³ The shift renewed investor interest across the sector, and shares of its largest names, including CrowdStrike and Palo Alto Networks, rose more than 70 percent between April and the end of May.⁴

Looking ahead, the question that shaped the first half remains unsettled. AI continued to drive demand for security, both to protect AI systems and to defend the wider attack surface that AI adoption created, while the sector's largest names continued to consolidate. The concern behind the February sell-off, that AI could eventually reduce the need for established vendors, was still unresolved as the period closed.

Performance Attribution

For the six-month period ending June 30, 2026, Nebius Group NV made the biggest contribution to the Fund, followed by Palo Alto Networks Inc. By weight, the Fund's largest holdings were Palo Alto Networks Inc., Fortinet Inc., and Nebius Group NV.

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Recent Developments

In 2026, global financial markets have continued to navigate an environment characterized by elevated geopolitical risk, evolving trade policy, and shifting expectations for monetary policy. The ongoing military conflict between the United States and Iran has heightened geopolitical uncertainty, disrupting energy supplies and shipping routes and contributing to significant volatility in commodity and financial markets. At the same time, trade measures and related negotiations among major economies remain subject to change in scope and duration, while central banks continue to weigh inflation dynamics against the need to support economic growth. Together, these developments have contributed to periodic volatility across asset classes, particularly in sectors sensitive to energy prices, interest rates, currency movements, and global supply chains. The ultimate course and impact of these developments remain uncertain, and accordingly, the potential financial implications for investments cannot be reliably determined at this time.

Related Party Transactions

Evolve Funds Group Inc. (the "Manager"), a corporation incorporated under the laws of the Province of Ontario, is the trustee, manager, and portfolio advisor of the Fund and is responsible for the day-to-day administration of the Fund. The Fund pays annual management fees to the Manager as consideration for its services. Any management fees paid to the Manager are related party transactions, as the Manager is considered to be a related party to the Fund. The management fees are disclosed in the statements of comprehensive income in the annual financial statements of the Fund and are discussed in greater detail below.

The Fund is permitted to purchase, sell and hold securities of certain issuers that are directly or indirectly related to the Manager. With respect to investment in related issuers, the Manager has relied on the approval that it has received from the Investment Review Committee ("IRC"). The Manager complies with its current policy and procedures regarding investments in related issuers and reports periodically to the IRC.

Management Fees

The Manager is entitled to an annual management fee of 0.40% of the net asset value of the Unhedged, Hedged, and US Dollar Unhedged ETF Units and the Hedged Class F Mutual Fund Units and 1.40% of the net asset value of the Hedged Class A Mutual Fund Units of the Fund, accrued daily and generally paid monthly in arrears. For the six-month period ended June 30, 2026, the Fund incurred \$400,129 in management fees. These management fees were received by the Manager for the day-to-day operations of the fund, including managing the portfolio, maintaining portfolio systems used to manage the Fund, maintaining the www.evolveetfs.com website, and providing all other services including marketing and promotion.

Administration Fees

The administration fees are calculated based on 0.15% per annum of the average daily net asset value of the Fund. The fees are accrued daily and are generally paid monthly. For the six-month period ended June 30, 2026, the Fund incurred \$148,163 in administration fees. These administration fees were received by the Manager for the following operating expenses of the Fund including but not limited to: mailing and printing expenses for periodic reports to unitholders; fees payable to the index provider, Registrar and Transfer Agent and Custodian; any reasonable out of pocket expenses incurred by the Manager or its agents in connection with their ongoing obligations to the Fund; IRC committee member fees and expenses in connection with the IRC; expenses related to compliance with NI 81-107; fees and expenses relating to voting of proxies by a third party; insurance coverage for the members of the IRC; fees payable to the auditors and legal advisors of the Fund; regulatory filing, stock exchange and licensing fees and CDS fees; costs and expenses of complying with all applicable laws, regulations and policies, including expenses and costs incurred in connection with the continuous public filing requirements such as permitted prospectus preparation and filing expenses; and legal, accounting and audit fees and fees and expenses of the Trustee, Custodian and Manager which are incurred in respect of matters not in the normal course of the Fund's activities. The administration fee paid to the Manager by the Fund may, in any particular period, be less than or exceed the operating expenses that the Manager incurs for the Fund.

A portfolio turnover rate of 100% is equivalent to the Fund buying and selling all of the securities in its portfolio once in the course of the period. The higher the Fund's portfolio turnover rate in a period, the greater the trading costs payable by the Fund in the period, and the greater the chance of an investor receiving taxable capital gains in the period. There is not necessarily a relationship between a high turnover rate and the performance of a fund.

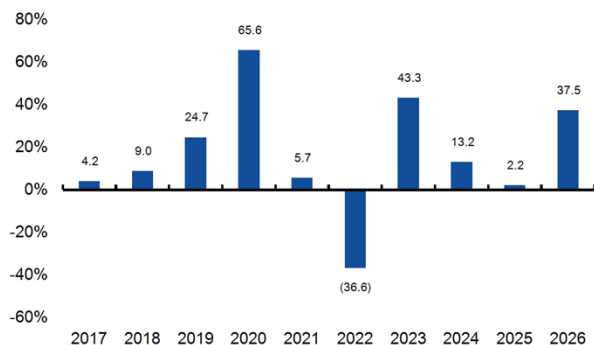
Year-by-Year Returns

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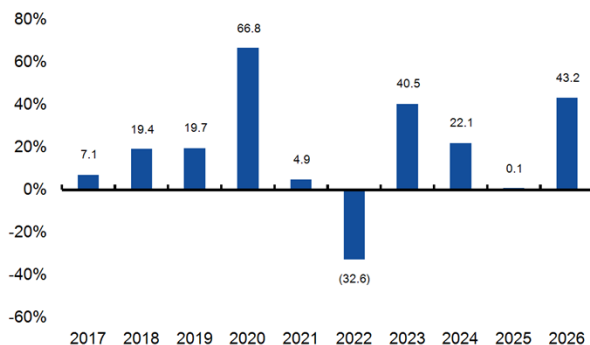
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CYBR Hedged ETF Units¹



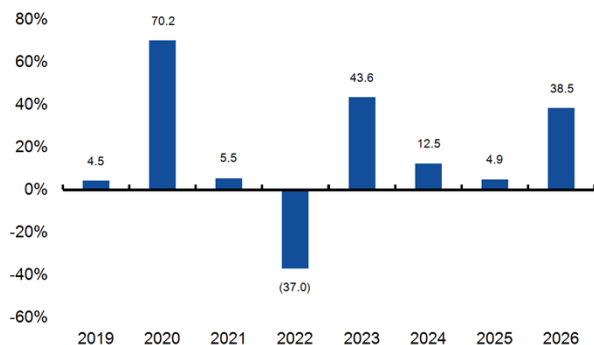

CYBR/B Unhedged ETF Units²



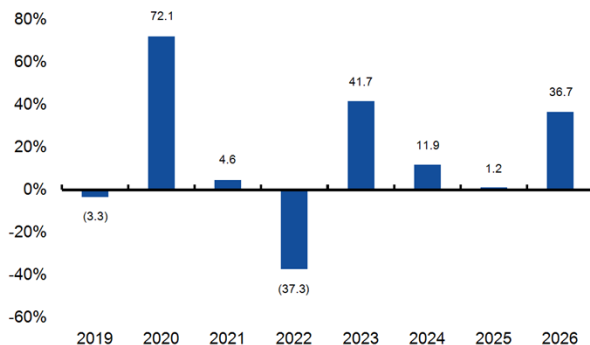

Hedged Class A Mutual Fund Units⁴

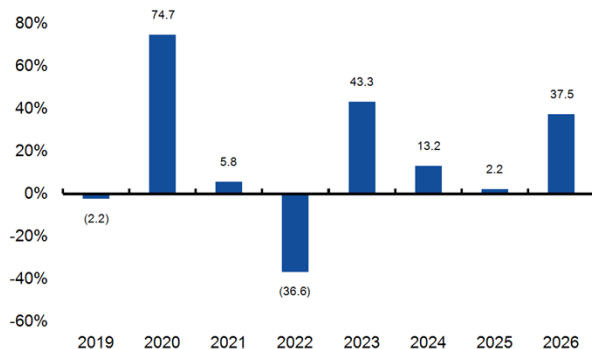
