Interim Management Report of Fund Performance

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Investment Objective and Strategies

The Premium Cash Management Fund (the "Fund") seeks to maximize current income, while at the same time preserving capital and maintaining liquidity, by investing primarily in Canadian dollar denominated high-quality short-term debt securities (with a term to maturity of 365 days or less).

Risk

There were no changes to the Fund over the period of this report that materially affected the level of risk associated with an investment in the Fund. Prospective investors should read the Fund's most recent prospectus and consider the description of risks contained therein.

Results of Operations

For the six-month period ended June 30, 2026, Unhedged ETF Units returned 1.1%. The Unhedged Class A Mutual Fund Units returned 1.0% and the Unhedged Class F Mutual Fund Units returned 1.1%. The Fund's net assets were \$395.0MM as at June 30, 2026.

Portfolio Manager Commentary

During the first half of 2026, the backdrop for Canadian money market funds was steady, with the Bank of Canada leaving its policy rate unchanged throughout the period. The Bank held the overnight target rate at 2.25% in late January, with inflation expected to remain near its 2% target,¹ and maintained that level in late April² and early June.³

The picture changed in the spring, when the conflict in the Middle East drove energy prices sharply higher and lifted inflation worldwide.² In Canada, CPI inflation climbed to 2.4% in March on higher gasoline prices² and reached 2.8% in April, an increase reflecting energy prices and carbon tax base-year effects, even as core inflation eased to around 2%.³ The Bank of Canada said it was looking through the near-term impact of higher energy prices but would not let them become persistent inflation.³

Looking ahead, the Bank of Canada expects inflation to hover around 3% in the near term before easing toward 2% and has said it stands ready to respond as the outlook evolves.³

Recent Developments

In 2026, global financial markets have continued to navigate an environment characterized by elevated geopolitical risk, evolving trade policy, and shifting expectations for monetary policy. The ongoing military conflict between the United States and Iran has heightened geopolitical uncertainty, disrupting energy supplies and shipping routes and contributing to significant volatility in commodity and financial markets. At the same time, trade measures and related negotiations among major economies remain subject to change in scope and duration, while central banks continue to weigh inflation dynamics against the need to support economic growth. Together, these developments have contributed to periodic volatility across asset classes, particularly in sectors sensitive to energy prices, interest rates, currency movements, and global supply chains. The ultimate course and impact of these developments remain uncertain, and accordingly, the potential financial implications for investments cannot be reliably determined at this time.

Related Party Transactions

Evolve Funds Group Inc. (the "Manager"), a corporation incorporated under the laws of the Province of Ontario, is the trustee, manager, and portfolio advisor of the Fund and is responsible for the day-to-day administration of the Fund. The Fund pays annual management fees to the Manager as consideration for its services. Any management fees paid to the Manager are related party transactions, as the Manager is considered to be a related party to the Fund. The management fees are disclosed in the statements of comprehensive income in the annual financial statements of the Fund and are discussed in greater detail below.

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The Fund is permitted to purchase, sell and hold securities of certain issuers that are directly or indirectly related to the Manager. With respect to investment in related issuers, the Manager has relied on the approval that it has received from the Investment Review Committee ("IRC"). The Manager complies with its current policy and procedures regarding investments in related issuers and reports periodically to the IRC.

Management Fees

The Manager is entitled to an annual management fee of 0.20% of the net asset value of the Unhedged ETF Units and the Unhedged Class F Mutual Fund Units and 0.45% of the net asset value of the Unhedged Class A Mutual Fund Units of the Fund, accrued daily and generally paid monthly in arrears. For the six-month period ended June 30, 2026, the Fund incurred \$526,705 in management fees. These management fees were received by the Manager for the day-to-day operations of the Fund, including managing the portfolio, maintaining portfolio systems used to manage the Fund, maintaining the www.evolveetfs.com website, and providing all other services including marketing and promotion.

Administration Fees

The administration fees are calculated based on 0.05% per annum of the average daily net asset value of the Fund. The fees are accrued daily and are generally paid monthly. For the six-month period ended June 30, 2026, the Fund incurred \$100,786 in administration fees. These administration fees were received by the Manager for the following operating expenses of the Fund including but not limited to: mailing and printing expenses for periodic reports to unitholders; Registrar and Transfer Agent and Custodian; any reasonable out of pocket expenses incurred by the Manager or its agents in connection with their ongoing obligations to the Fund; IRC committee member fees and expenses in connection with the IRC; expenses related to compliance with NI 81-107; fees and expenses relating to voting of proxies by a third party; insurance coverage for the members of the IRC; fees payable to the auditors and legal advisors of the Fund; regulatory filing, stock exchange and licensing fees and CDS fees; costs and expenses of complying with all applicable laws, regulations and policies, including expenses and costs incurred in connection with the continuous public filing requirements such as permitted prospectus preparation and filing expenses; and legal, accounting and audit fees and fees and expenses of the Trustee, Custodian and Manager which are incurred in respect of matters not in the normal course of the Fund's activities. The administration fee paid to the Manager by the Fund may, in any particular period, be less than or exceed the operating expenses that the Manager incurs for the Fund.

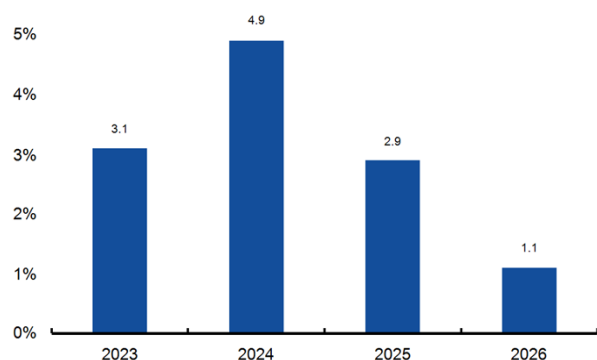
Past Performance

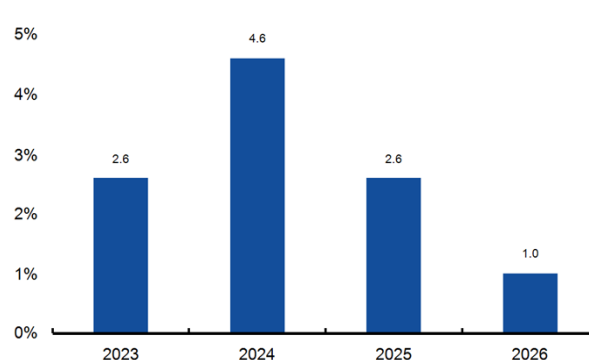
Year-by-Year Returns

Unhedged Class A Mutual Fund Units²



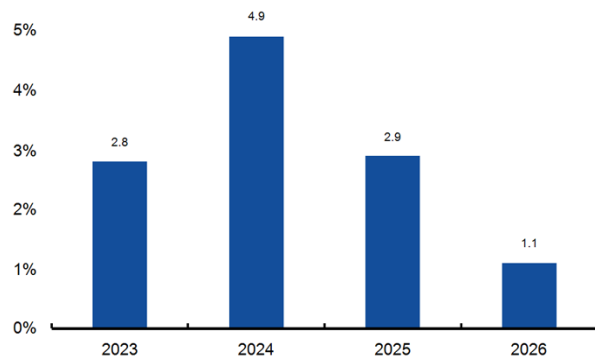
